MOVEMENT CONTROL PERIOD – ONLINE TEACHING AND LEARNING TO BE SUSPENDED

All INTEC's employees are required to refer to UiTM Holdings Group of Companies' internal memorandum issued today and the accompanying guidelines. This update is referring to the Guidelines issued by Jabatan Pendidikan Tinggi (JPT) regarding the spreading of Covid-19 in Malaysia.

Jabatan Pendidikan Tinggi (JPT) had on 17 March 2020 at 10.48PM, announced the decision to suspend all teaching and learning activities including online learning, test, student development activities and research starting 18 March to 31 March 2020. Therefore, all lecturers need to hold all exams, tests and classes that were scheduled to be done via online during this period.

The guidelines also stressed that all operations in public and private higher-learning institutions will be fully shut down. In the letter by JPT, all institutions are required to follow the guidelines strictly to avoid the spread of Covid-19. The guidelines are already in force starting 18 March 2020.

Taking into consideration of the rapidly evolving situation, INTEC will keep close monitoring on the situation and shall provide updates on its operation via its electronic mediums such as email, social media platforms and official website. Everyone's health and safety remained as INTEC's top priority during this time, and we thank you for your support and patience as we work together to stem the spread of COVID-19.
