- Pre-University** Pass Pre-University/A-Level/Matriculation/Asasi/ STPM from any recognised institution with minimum CGPA 3.00
- Degree** Pass Degree in Accountancy from any recognised institution with minimum CGPA 2.75; **or** Pass Degree in Business / Finance from any recognised and institution with minimum CGPA 2.75 and minimum one (1) year working experience in related field
